



Lulu's cowl

Yarn: Five skeins of Illimani Yarns Cadena 1 (49 yards / 45 meters in 100 g)
(super bulky (5-6 wpi) (71% Alpaca and 28% Merino)

Needle size: US 12 circular or regular needles

Size: approx. 15" x 38" (in cm, 38 x 96.5)

Pattern notes:

The Illimani Cadena 1 is simply the answer to the knitter's prayer...a super bulky yarn, almost as soft as royal alpaca and it does not shed!! Mission impossible has been accomplished with the help of the highest grade of merino wool (19 microns) along with a chained construction.

Abbreviations:

Sl - slip stitch

K1 - knit one

K2tog - knit two stitches together

Yo - yarn over



Instructions:

Cast on 32 sts.

Row 1: Sl 1, *K1, (yo, k2tog) twice; repeat from * end k1

Repeat row 1 every row until you have just enough yarn to bind off. Bind off all stitches loosely...

Sew three buttons at one end on one side.

Under those three buttons, sew three small hooks (you can find them at your fabric store) on the other side. That way you can use the three hooks to wear your cowl the way you feel you should wear it! Depending on how the day goes or how the wind blows!
