

sumac scarf



Perfectly reversible with strong vertical patterning, the Sumac scarf was inspired by the stain glass interpretations of sumac trees by Frank Lloyd Wright. This scarf is simple to make, with only one pattern row repeated throughout. It makes the ideal accessory for either women or men.

Materials: 2 x Illimani Royal Alpaca 100g

Needles: 4.5mm (US 7)

Tension: 25 sts = 4" on 4.5mm (US 7) needles over pattern stitch

Finished measurements: 8.5" x 60"

With 4.5mm (US 7) needles, cast on 55 sts.

Pattern row: *[K1, P1] 5 times, place marker, K5, place marker* Repeat between *'s 3 times. [K1, P1] 5 times. Repeat this row, slipping markers, until scarf measures 60" from the cast on edge. Cast off.
